

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS WINDOW FILMS - FROSTED & ULTRA CLEAR

As with any quality product, proper care and maintenance will extend the useful life of your wall film and help maintain its original beauty and finish.

Cleaning:

To clean digitally printed window films, follow these steps:
